

Your arrival in the flat

If your arrival is from Monday to Friday during our office hours, a person of our team will meet you at the pre-arranged time in front of the building of your room.

If you cannot make it during these hours or you arrive during the weekend it could be that the person who welcomes you is one of your flat mates and that you meet the person of our team the next working day.

We encourage you to promote a friendly and nice spirit in the flat at all times, being helpful and supportive with your flat mates, since we think it is the key for a peaceful and nice time in the flat, and also in the city. Therefore, we would like to ask you, that one of the first things you do when you arrive in your new home is to introduce yourself to your new flat mates.

When you meet the person of our team, either the day of your arrival or the first working day, you will double check the room together and fill in the inventory form (making sure everything is as it's supposed to be to avoid any future problems), make any pending payments you might have (please notice that we encourage all the payments to be made via bank transfer because consider it is the safest to handle money), sign the contract and receive the keys.

Please, notice you have 3 days after the day of your arrival to notify any damage or failure in your room, furniture or any shared part of the flat.

In addition to this, you can take this opportunity for meeting with one of our team members to ask any questions you might still have concerning the accommodation or the life in Barcelona.

In the following pages, you can also find useful (and important) information to make your stay in Barcelona enjoyable, easy, peaceful and safe.

- **Arrive to Barcelona**

The Barcelona airport is about 10km from the city center. It has two terminals (T1 and T2), and there are different public transportations that will connect them with the city center. Here we provide which are the best alternatives you can use depending on where you are going to be staying:

C/ Balmes 64

- If you are coming from Terminal 1, the best option is to use Aerobus 1 (A1) until Plaça Universitat, which will take you 35-40 minutes. Once you arrive to Plaça Universitat, you have a 5 minute walk until the apartment.

- If you are coming from Terminal 2, the best option is to use Aerobus 2 (A2) until Plaça Universitat, which will take you 35-40 minutes. Once you arrive to Plaça Universitat, you have a 5 minute walk until the apartment.

C/ Pau Claris, 128

- If you are coming from Terminal 1, the best option is to use Aerobus 1 (A1) until Plaça Espanya, which will take you about 20 minutes, and then use the metro at Plaça Espanya (L3 – green line) until Passeig de Gràcia, which will take you 10 minutes. Then you have less than 5 minute walk until the apartment.
- If you are coming from Terminal 2, the best option is to use the train R2N (direction Sant Celoni) until Passeig de Gràcia, which would take you about 30 minutes. From Passeig de Gràcia you have less than 5 minute walk until the apartment.

C/ Consell de Cent, 227

- If you are coming from Terminal 1, the best option is to use Aerobus 1 (A1) until Gran Via – Comte Borrell, which will take you about 30 minutes, and then you have a 5 minute walk until the apartment.
- If you are coming from Terminal 2, the best option is to use Aerobus 2 (A2) until Gran Via – Comte Borrell, which will take you about 30 minutes, and then you have a 5 minute walk until the apartment.

C/ Avinyó, 8

- If you are coming from Terminal 1, the best option is to use Aerobus 1 (A1) until Plaça Espanya, which will take you about 20 minutes, and then use the metro at Plaça Espanya (L3 – green line) until Liceu, which will take you about 5-10 minutes. Then you have less than 5 minute walk until the apartment.
- If you are coming from Terminal 2, the best option is to use Aerobus 2 (A2) until Plaça Espanya, which will take you about 20 minutes, and then use the metro at Plaça Espanya (L3 – green line) until Liceu, which will take you about 5-10 minutes. Then you have less than 5 minute walk until the apartment.

AEROBUS

As you can see, the most feasible way to get to the city center from the airport is by taking the Aerobus. There are two buses every 10 minutes that connect the airport with Plaça Espanya and Plaça Catalunya, where you can connect with any other public transportation method.

These buses are adapted for travelers and have space to pack your luggage. The price of a ticket is 5,90 € one-way and 10,20 round trip. There is free wifi on board at the Aerobus.

The cost of the metro and train are 2.15 € one-way. It will always be best if you buy other tickets that give you more than one ride, because they will be much cheaper. In another section we will explain in detail every available ticket of the Barcelona Public Transportation System.

TAXI

Remember you can also take a cab, which is much easier! The only inconvenience is the price, which can oscillate between 30 € and 50 € depending on how far the apartment is.
